230. PUBLIC PERFORMANCES BY STUDENTS	
1. Purpose	The Joint Operating Committee recognizes the value of students sharing their talents and skills with the community through student participation and performances in public events.
2. Authority	The Joint Operating Committee endorses public performances by students when they constitute a learning experience that contributes to the educational program; they do not interfere with other scheduled activities, and the circumstances of the event do not pose a threat to the health, safety or well-being of the students who will be involved.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	All requests for public performances by student groups require the approval of the Principal/Vocational Director.  The Executive Director shall develop procedures to implement this policy.
4. Guidelines	Parental permission shall be sought and received before students may participate.  No student shall be compelled to participate in a public performance or be penalized in any way for failure to do so.
Pol. 204	When public performances are scheduled as a regular part of a course of study taken for credit, students shall be informed in advance of their obligation to participate; and they will be excused from participation only in accordance with the rules and procedures governing school attendance.  No student, group of students or employees of this Joint Operating Committee may receive compensation for a performance in public of students organized as a school representative.
