237. ELECTRONIC DEVICES

1. Authority
 SC 1317.1

The Joint Operating Committee (JOC) prohibits possession of laser pointers and attachments and telephone paging devices/beepers by students on school property, on buses and other vehicles provided by the district, and at school-sponsored activities.

SC 510

The Joint Operating Committee prohibits the visibility and use of cellular phones and any electronic devices that have the capability to take photographs or record audio or video by students during the school day. The school day is defined as from the beginning of the school day until dismissal.

The Joint Operating Committee prohibits the misuse of electronic devices. Disciplinary and/or legal action may be taken as defined in the Student Code of Conduct and applicable laws.

In addition, the Joint Operating Committee prohibits access by students through a wireless, unfiltered connection to the internet.

The Career Center shall not be liable for the loss, damage or misuse of any electronic device brought to school by a student.

2. Delegation of
 Responsibility

The Executive Director or designee shall annually notify students, parents/guardians and staff about the Career Center's electronic device policy by publishing such policy in the student handbook, newsletters, posted notices, and other efficient methods.

Exceptions to the prohibitions set forth in this policy may be made for health, safety or emergency reasons with prior approval of the building principal or designee, or when use is provided for in a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) or Section 504 Service Agreement.
