Students will gain a solid foundation in the Veterinary Sciences Technology program on which to build a post-secondary degree. The Veterinary Assistant program may lead to additional career pathways such as Animal Trainer, Animal Breeder, Non-Farm and Laboratory Animal Caretaker, Groomer, Animal Control Officer, Veterinary Technician or Technologist, and Veterinarian. Students will have the opportunity to earn the following recognized industry certifications: Purina Certified Weight Coach, Pet Tech First Aid and CPR.
